

Year 7 Catch-Up 2015-16 Impact

In 2015/16 schools received an additional £500 for each pupil in Year 7 who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of KS2. There were 17 students eligible for catch-up funding. $17 \times £500 = \mathbf{£8,500}$

Planned intervention

English

- One-to-one intervention.
- KS3 grammar/reading textbooks purchased and used with students.

Mathematics

- 'Digit by Digit' mentoring by Year 10 students.
- 1:1 staff intervention during timetabled lessons.
- Lunch time club aimed at catch-up students and also open to any year 7 students who would benefit from practising maths in a different way. Staffed by practitioners who have a particular strength with Year 7 using engaging, fun maths ideas.
- Whole school Inset planned to develop differentiation of teaching across the curriculum.

By the end of the summer term, **82%** of Year 7 catch-up students achieved or exceeded their aspirational targets in English and **94%** achieved them in maths.
